2. iTUNES AND IPOD SUBSCRIPTION

- Select which method of delivery you would like to receive the podcast. iTunes is very popular, and you don't have to have an iPod to listen to it.
- When finished with the questions, select "REGISTER"
- Click on the icon for iTunes on the thank you page. You will be taken to the subscription page for The Wine Scout in the iTunes music store. It's a free subscription. Select "SUBSCRIBE"

3. RSS FEED

- Register for The Wine Scout. Answer the questionnaire and give us your email address.
- Select which method of delivery you would like to receive the podcast. iTunes is very popular, and you don't have to have an iPod to listen to it.

- Click on the icon for RSS on the thank you page. You will be taken to the RSS code page for inclusion in your podcatcher.
